



Moulton Elementary Science Fair Registration Timeline

1. **Monday, February 9th, 2026** – Kick off Science Fair; registration form and checklist will be sent home in backpacks this week.
2. **Thursday, February 26th, 2026** - Registration Forms are due and are to be turned into your teacher for Signature.
*Once approved by your teacher, forms will be turned into our PTA Science Chair, Kristin Rubio. Mrs. Rubio will review to ensure each project meets requirements.
3. **Thursday, February 26th, 2026 – Tuesday, March 3rd, 2026**: Registration forms will be reviewed. If any revisions are necessary, the form will be immediately returned to the student with a date stamp. Students will have 2 days to complete any revisions and turn forms back in to their teacher.
4. **Wednesday, March 4th, 2026**: Acceptance letter will be emailed to parents regarding their student's project, and a final participation list will be posted on the PTA Website. ***Once your experiment is approved you may not make any changes.** Website: <https://www.moultonpta.org/science-fair>
5. **Thursday, March 5th, 2026**: Science Fair Backboards/Display boards should begin to be created.
6. **Wednesday, March 25th, 2026**: 4th/5th grade projects due to the drop off location, which is just outside of the MPR, before school starts (7:45am) the MPR will be open from 7:30-8:00am. Throughout the school day, our 4th and 5th grade students will have the opportunity to present their science fair project to a panel of judges.
7. **Thursday, March 26th, 2026**: K-3 grades projects are due to the MPR, before school starts (7:45am) The MPR will be open from 7:30-8:00am.
8. **Thursday, March 26th, 2026**: Science Fair located in the MPR from 5:00-7:00 pm (Winner announcement at 6:45PM)
9. **Friday, March 27th, 2026**: Please plan to pick up your student's Science Fair project after school in the MPR on Friday, March 27. Any projects not picked up by the end of the day will be disposed of.
