



## Moulton Elementary Science Fair Participant Information (4th-5th Grade)

### Display Boards

- Please refer to **page 12** of the [Science Fair Planning Guide](#) for display board guidelines and an example layout.
- The display board should be the **final step** of your project. Be sure all parts of your experiment are completed and laid out before attaching anything to the board.
- Please ensure you write your name on the back of your display board.

### Turning Your Experiment In

- 4th and 5th grade experiments are **DUE Wednesday, March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026**. Please deliver your completed backboard and any display items to The MPR before school starts. The MPR will be open from 7:30-8:00 am.

### Judging

- **Judging for 4th and 5th grade students will take place on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, during the school day.** Students will be released from class or lunch/recess to present their experiment to a panel of judges.
- **Please don't stress about judging!** Relax, have fun, and enjoy sharing your experiment, we can't wait to hear all about it.
- Students will have the opportunity to showcase their projects to a friendly panel of judges who will provide constructive feedback. This experience provides students with an opportunity to formally present their work and address any inquiries. All students will be evaluated impartially, with top presentations and projects receiving a prize and award. Like their younger counterparts, each student will also receive a participation certificate.

### Science Fair

- The Science Fair will take place on **Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 5:00 - 7:15pm** in the MPR. (This event takes place the same evening as Open House.)
- A short ceremony will be held at 6:45pm in The MPR to recognize grade-level winners and present participation awards.
- Science Fair Projects will remain on display until after school on Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026, in the MPR.
- Please plan to have your child pick up their science project on Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup> after school in the MPR. Any project not picked up by Friday by 3pm will be disposed of.

**\*Grades 4 and 5 will turn in their project on Wed., March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026, to allow time for judging.**

**\*Grades TK-3 will turn in their project the morning of the fair Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2026.**
